



A vaccine for Coronavirus

Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a new virus that is spread easily between people. Older people including those with dementia are at most risk of becoming very unwell if they get coronavirus. There is no cure for the virus yet, but a lot of scientists are working to make a vaccine that will protect us from COVID-19.

Some vaccines are being tested on volunteers. But no one so far has found a vaccine that works.

There is no evidence that any of the vaccines being tested are harmful to people of African, Asian, Caribbean or other minority ethnic origin.
